

If the notion of hosting a Thanksgiving gathering or cooking a turkey with all the fixings in a New York-sized apartment is overwhelming, you're not alone. Luckily, you live in a city where the options for a prix-fixe Thanksgiving feast at a nearby restaurant are basically endless. We've gathered some of the best options around town, just be sure to make your reservation very soon!

The Peak | Hudson Yards

The Peak is perched 101 floors above Hudson Yards and is the only restaurant pairing roast turkey with panoramic views of Manhattan. The three-course holiday menu includes salt-baked sweet potato, fennel sausage stuffing, Atlantic scallops, and cranberry sauce that will put grandma to shame. Pricing varies by view beginning at \$175, up to \$225 for a corner window.

L'Amico | Midtown

L'Amico is one of the best upscale options for a Thanksgiving meal in Midtown Manhattan. With a focus on southern Italian cuisine, some favorite selections include the butternut squash soup, dry-aged prime rib, and pecan pie with bourbon-date gelato. The prix-fixe is \$84 and an additional \$36 for a wine pairing.

Chola | Midtown

If turkey isn't your thing, check out Chola, a coastal Indian restaurant in Midtown. Don't be fooled by the restaurant's \$20 price tag for the all-you-can-eat Thanksgiving buffet. The restaurant boats rave reviews from hundreds of New Yorkers, and it's no surprise looking at their holiday specials which include pumpkin bharta, goat biryani, cranberry chutney, and stuffed dosas.

Miss Lily's | East Village

Miss Lily's is one of the top-rated Caribbean restaurants in the city and will serve some serious island heat this Thanksgiving. For \$58 per guest, you can enjoy slow-roasted jerk turkey, mac-and-cheese pie, Jamaican callaloo greens, and pumpkin pie with pimento whipped cream.



Le Crocodile | Williamsburg

On the ground floor of Brooklyn's Wythe Hotel, you'll find <u>Le Crocodile</u>, an impeccably designed French brasserie. For Thanksgiving, guests can select a la carte dishes or family-style prix-fixe for \$105. Entrees for the table include a whole roasted capon in gravy, or a halibut in chestnut sauce.

Margie's | Rockaway Beach

The recently-opened <u>Margie's</u> is a casual-chic destination at The Rockaway Hotel in Rockaway Beach. Their three-course holiday prix-fixe menu is a cool \$55 per person and includes honey roasted parsnip soup, herb brined turkey, and spiced pumpkin mousse among other seasonal specialties.

The Ribbon | Upper West Wide

The Ribbon is often lauded as one of the best brunch spots on Manhattan's Upper West Side. On November 24, the American-style eatery will bring back its traditional Thanksgiving dine-in or take-out feast. Mains include a selection of turkey, salmon, or steak, finished with pumpkin bread pudding or pecan pie.

Osprey | DUMBO

On November 26, visit <u>The Osprey</u> at the waterfront One Hotel in DUMBO for an upscale Brooklyn Thanksgiving. Prix fixe dinner is \$95 per person with selections that include miso pumpkin soup, beef short rib, mushroom risotto, and s'mores jars. When you're done, walk off the meal along the winding Brooklyn Bridge Park esplanade that flanks the East River.
