Courtyard Comedy at The Three Monkeys

The Three Monkeys pub in Hell's Kitchen has redecorated their outdoor courtyard to host a series of comics and comediennes this fall. Visitors can expect a line-up of talent with credits from HBO, Netflix and Comedy Central. While the event is free to attend, you will need to RSVP in advance and purchase at least two items night of show.

Ambush Comedy at The Tiny Cupboard

The Tiny Cupboard in Bushwick, Brooklyn is referred to by locals as the tiniest bar in New York City. This fall, the venue repurposed their rooftop space for weekly sunset comedy shows with expanded food and drink service. • "Baby Shower" Stand-Up at East River Park

"Baby Shower" is one of the most popular outdoor stand-up shows to debut this year. The show takes place every Thursday at the East River Park Amphitheater and reservations are completely free.
